REQUESTS FOR STUDENT'S SICKNESS/ MITIGATING CIRCUMSTANCES CERTIFICATE

The University Health Service receives many requests for letters confirming illness or mitigating circumstances. Unfortunately, we cannot always provide these.

Please note that we can only provide letters if:

- 1. The doctor can confirm on the basis of <u>prior</u> documentary medical evidence (eg previous practice consultations, admissions to hospital, clinic appointments etc.)
- 2. The doctor can confirm on the basis of current <u>objective</u> clinical signs (and not just self-reported symptoms).

Please note: Your GP may ask you to make an appointment at the surgery to discuss this further.
